School Bus Behavior Policy

The European School expects students to display the same high standards of behavior we have come to expect in school, when using school transport. This policy outlines the expected standards of behavior, via a Code of Conduct and provides the possible sanctions for breaking these standards.

The following Code of Conduct applies to students travelling on school buses.

Students must:

- Respect the rights of other passengers to a safe and enjoyable journey.
- Follow the driver's directions without argument.
- Not damage the bus property, equipment or signs.
- Sit one student per one seat.
- Remain seated throughout the journey and use a seatbelt if one is provided.
- Wait for the bus to stop before standing to get off.
- Use mobile phones at a sensible noise level and in a manner that doesn't break the Code of Conduct.

Student must NOT:

- Speak to or distract the driver unless there is an emergency.
- Talk loudly or shout.
- Eat or drink on the bus.
- Use foul or abusive language on the bus.
- Bully, fight or display aggressive behavior.
- Throw items inside or outside of the bus.
- Block the aisle or seats during the journey.
- Change seats during the journey.
- Use a recording device to obtain images, audio or video of the driver or any passengers.

Sanctions for Unacceptable Behavior

As part of its commitment to providing a safe environment for the transport of students to and from school the school administration reserves the right to impose sanctions if a student's behavior on bus is deemed unacceptable. If a student breaches the Code of Conduct and action is required, this will be assessed on a case by-case basis.

Sanctions:

Minor Incidents - Warning Letter or Phone Call to Parent.

Moderate Incidents – Three days Suspension from the school bus.

Severe Incidents – Dismissal from the school bus for the remainder of the school year.
