Amounts of tuition fees at “European School” Ltd, rules for their payment and Attraction of School Funds

Article 1. General Provisions

This Rule (hereinafter referred to as the "Rule") establishes the tuition fee for curriculum(Georgian Program; International Baccalaureate - IB, American School of Advanced Studies - ASAS) and the Kindergarten/ Preschool Education Center at “European School” LTD (hereinafter referred to as the School), rules of their payment and the conditions of discounts, as well as the rules of attracting financial resources of the school.

Article 2. Payment of Tuition Fee

1. Payment of the tuition fee is defined in two stages:

I stage - half of the tuition fee, namely 50% should be paid in advance, prior/before to the beginning of the relevant academic year, namely before 31 May;

II stage - payment of the remaining amount, namely 50% of the tuition fee shall be made before December 15 of the relevant academic year.

2. The student can pay the tuition fee in full before the start of the study.

3. The tuition fee of the International Baccalaureate DP Program (XI-XII Class), Class XI- XII of American School of Advanced Studies (ASAS) and Class XII of Georgian Program should be paid in full before the start of the academic year, namely before 31 May and in this case the students shall not enjoy the 5% discount provided for in Section 1 of Article 5 of this Policy.

4. If, due to the date of enrollment of a person in school, it is impossible to meet the deadlines provided for in paragraph 1 of this article, the terms and conditions of payment of tuition fees shall be determined by the service contract with him / her parent / legal representative.

5. The tuition fee should be paid by transfer of amount to the bank account of the School, in the national currency, according to the official exchange rate fixed by the National Bank by the date of payment.

6. The tuition fee can be paid in the euros, if the payment is made from a foreign bank account.

Article 3. Return of the Amount Paid

If the agreement between the school and the student terminates until the end of the academic year, the student's legal representative has the right to demand return of the pre-paid tuition fee only for the remaining period.

Article 4. The Amount of Tuition Fee

The cost tuition fee for Georgian citizens (also citizen of Georgia with dual citizenship) and citizens of foreign country shall be determined according to the table below:

Article 5. Discount Offer

1. The discount offer shall determined according to the table below:

N	Discount terms	Discount interest
1	If 3 children from one family are studying (per child)	15%
2	If 4 and more children from one family are studying (per child)	25%
3	In case of full payment of the tuition fee for the next academic year by September 1 (provided that at least 50% of the tuition fee has been paid no later than May 31)	5%
4	Discounts announced through the official communication channels of the school during the open day (applies only to the cost of tuition for the first academic year)	10%
5	Children of foreign diplomatic missions and international organizations in Georgia (per child)	15%
6	Children of employees of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Georgia (per child)	10%

2. When paying the tuition fee, other conditions of discount different from those provided for in this Article may be used, based on the decision of the school founder / partner and / or the supervisory board, which may be concluded by the decision of the founder / partner and / or supervisory board or be included in the agreement with student's parent / legal guardian.

3. The school director/administrative manager of the school is authorized to make a decision on the use / determination of the discount condition different from the one provided for in this article and / or full or partial exemption from the payment of tuition fees. This decision is made by agreement with the student's parent / legal guardian or by a school legal act, which may also determine the tuition fee payment terms / conditions.

4. From the terms of the discount approved in the first paragraph of this article, only one condition of the discount may be used, unless otherwise determined by the decision of the Supervisory Board.

5. In exceptional cases, 5% discount offer can be used along with other discount offer, if the student pays the full amount of the tuition fee for the following year is paid by September 1 (at least 50% no later than May 31, the remaining 50% - no later than 1 September). In this case, the already discounted tuition fee will be reduced by 5% (on terms of other discount).

6. In order to apply the relevant discount condition to the children, the employees of foreign diplomatic missions and international organizations in Georgia should present a certificate from the workplace or a relevant document confirming the above.

#### Article 6. Attracting Financial Resources

1. Attracting financial resources falls within the competence of the administrative manager of the School.

2. The School administrative manager shall submit plans for attracting financial funds to the Supervisory Board of the School three months before the start of the academic year.

#### Article 7. Final Provisions

The School Administrative Manager, the Chief Accountant and Admissions and Enrollment Division of the European School are responsible for the implementation of the present Policy.
